The meeting was called to order by President Porter at 11:11 a.m. Quorum was present.

Officers' Reports

Secretary's Report: Minutes from the May 9, 2024 meeting were reviewed. Motion made, seconded and approved via voice vote with no corrections.

Treasurer's Report: Treasurer Engelter reported the current checking account balance is \$17,191.30. Motion to accept the report passed via voice vote without dissent.

Other Directors' Reports: None offered.

<u>Committee Reports</u> (committees without report not noted)

Ad Hoc Project Committee – Newspapers Digitalization:

- Boxes (18) remain in Director Huettl's garage awaiting shipment to Newspapers.com
- Returned cartons of newspapers remain stored in the museum building.
- Discussion with the City of Mandan representatives have confirmed that CONEX boxes/shipping containers cannot be used at the museum site since thesy are only approved for industrial-zoned use. Museum land is currently zoned agricultural.
- Efforts to set up "Go Fund Me" page to fund a CONEX/shipping container is suspended
- Railroad museum has offered cold storage in one of their outdoor box storages. Potential damage to the newspapers is acknowledged.
- Potential donors have been encouraged to use the PayPal donation page on the website

- Webpage additions (2) Gone Forever Old Red Trail and Liberty Memorial Bridge

Donations & Acquisitions Committee

• A large (4'x 4') stone panel with a likely Rybnicek carving offered. Apparently recovered during 1994 Main Street rebuild project (which included the removal of pieces of abandoned trolley track.) Consensus to install it outside along the north fence line west of the First Street Federal Building cornerstone display. Additional research on its providence is necessary and is in progress.

- Current balance \$18,502.36
